Bay Area Crisis Nursery helps to keep families safe and together, preventing children from entering the foster care system and supporting families in alleviating the effects of poverty.

California Shakespeare Theater (Cal Shakes) creates exemplary productions of works, both old and new, interpreted in vital and urgent ways.

Camp Kesem is led by college students to create a community of empathy and emotional support for children through and beyond a parent's cancer.

Cancer Support Community provides free programs with the goal of helping people facing cancer become healthier, live longer, and live better.

Court Appointed Special Advocates Program (CASA)

works with the most vulnerable children in our community those who have been abused, neglected, or abandoned.

Diablo Day Camp offers summer camp for an average of 1,400 campers from age 2-18 years, with some 450 dedicated volunteers.

Early Alert Canines trains Diabetic Alert Dogs and specializes in supporting families with children who have Typel diabetes.

The Food Bank of Contra Costa and Solano strives to serve all people experiencing hunger or food insecurity and commits to never turning anyone away.

Friends of Troop 224 is the Chartering Organization for both Troop 224 (boys & girls).

Gold Coast Chamber Players provides vibrant concert experiences with ongoing series and also provides engaging classroom experiences in public schools. Grateful Gatherings improves lives by providing new and gently used furniture and household goods to low-income families transitioning out of homelessness, crisis, and poverty.

Hope Solutions helps to heal the effects of poverty and homelessness by providing permanent housing solutions and vital support services (formerly Contra Costa Interfaith Housing)

The Lafayette Historical Society believes in the power of history to ignite the imagination, stimulate thought and provide enjoyment.

The Lafayette Library and Learning Center Foundation sustains the Lafayette Library as a vibrant community resource that offers enriching experiences for all ages.

Lafayette Partners in Education (LPIE) supports and enriches the education of every child in the Lafayette public schools.

Lamorinda Arts Council ignites and sustains artistic expression and appreciation for all ages throughout Lamorinda.

Lamorinda Spirit Van provides affordable, accessible transportation for Lamorinda older adults, who often have agebased disabilities and no longer drive.

Lamorinda Village provides Lamorinda residents (55+) with the means to age in place in their own homes and communities with safety, dignity, and independence.

Mindful Littles bridges mindfulness and self-compassion with direct volunteerism opportunities for TK-8th grade children through their Mindful Service Learning program.
